### 1/2 point

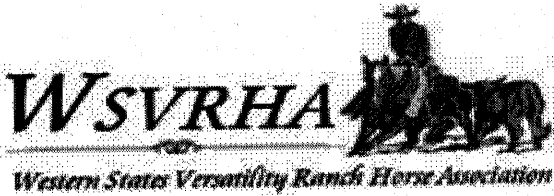
